## SOFTBALL (6-10, 2-3 NEWMAC)

### LAST WEEK

The Cougars defeated Bridgewater State 4-1 in game one of a double-header on Tuesday. Junior **Lauren Ackein** hit two home runs including a home run in her first at-bat of the game. Ackein hit her second home run in her next at-bat. Junior **Kaitlin Kelly** had two hits in game one and an RBI. The Bears defeated the Cougars 8-4 in game two. Ackein collected two more hits and three RBI while Kelly went 3-for-4 with a run scored.

The Cougars defeated WPI 6-4 in game one of a NEWMAC double-header on Friday. Junior **Julie Muszalski** hit a two-run single in the bottom of the sixth to lead the Cougars to the win. Sophomore pitcher Heather Warren improved to 5-2 on the mound. For the second time in three games, Ackein hit a home run in her first at-bat of the game. WPI defeated Clark 13-9 in game two. Graduate student **Jackie Demore** had three hits including her first collegiate home run. She went 3-for-4 with three RBI. Senior **Kelly Christensen** had two hits and two runs scored.

In NEWMAC action on Saturday, Wellesley swept Clark 4-3 in 11 innings and 7-3. In two games, Christensen had four hits, one stolen base and an RBI for the Cougars. DeMore and sophomore **Heather Warren** both collected three hits. Christensen extended her hitting streak to 16 straight games. She is batting .464 with 26 hits including eight doubles, a triple and two home runs. She has recorded nine RBI and 11 runs scored. Christensen is third in the conference in batting average.

Ackein ignited the Clark offense last week with three home runs in five games and was named the NEWMAC Player of the Week. From the lead off position she dramatically set the tone of the game by hitting the first pitch out of the park against Bridgewater State and WPI. In the first game against Bridgewater she followed her lead off home run with another homer in her second at bat. Lauren drove in six runs while hitting .316 for the week. She added a double and two singles to lead Clark to a victory against WPI and a split with Bridgewater State.
