2005 Mid-Season Review

Under the direction of second-year head coach Lisa Meola '98, the Clark University women's tennis team opened the 2005 fall season with a 6-3 victory over Regis



College. The young team returns six players from last year and no seniors. Junior co-captains Alycia Weiner and Emily Slack are providing excellent leadership for the Cougars. Sophomores Rebecca Brenner, Kristen Domurad, Ashley Faden and Mika Sneddon gained valuable experience last year. Joining the 2005 squad are two first-years, Rebecca Good and Emily Luhrs.

The Cougars play a very difficult conference schedule but have competed well in non-conference action during the first half of the season. The Cougars lost a tough match to Nichols College, 3-6, and then dominated Pine Manor College, 9-0. Individually Domurad has posted a 4-3 record at #5/#6 singles and Weiner has won three singles matches at #3 and three doubles matches at #2.

The team is hopeful that despite the losses that playing against such talented conference opponents in the first half of the season will prepare them well to compete at a higher level in the latter part of the season and tally some more victories.
